**Bullying Prevention Is Up To Everyone**  
How to deal with bullying is an important discussion to have at this time of year. Talk about responsibilities of bystanders, the students who "just mind their own business and stay out of trouble." Remind your child/ren that: If an adult is nearby, a bystander's responsibility is to:

1. **Say "Stop!"** to the bully.
2. **Walk away** if the bully doesn't stop the aggressive behavior.
3. **Tell an adult** what is going on.

If there's no adult, a bystander should:

1. **Be a Friend.** Stand near the victim. Label the act: "That's bullying!"
2. **Call others to help.** "Come Jeremy needs help!"
3. **Reduce the audience.** Tell onlookers, "What are you looking at?! You should help stop this!"
4. **Report the incident** to an adult as soon as possible.
