#### The Key to Your Child's Success!

Show your child you think school is important. Stay positive about school and schoolwork.

Spend time talking with your child about school every day. Here are some examples:

- "What was the hardest (or most interesting) thing you did today?"
- "What was the most challenging part of your math test?"
- "Who did you sit with at lunch today?"

Get to know your child's teacher. If possible, spend some time in your child's class.

Read aloud to your child. Reading helps kids develop the skill of listening. Set aside

10 or 15 minutes each day. Be sure to choose a book you both enjoy. Stop
